Thank you to everyone who responded to our survey this year. 28% of parents and 86% of pupils responded. It is pleasing to hear so many parents and pupils are happy with our school. The actions and updates from last year's survey 2018-19

- To ensure parents are well informed about opportunities for girls
- Review the use of planners in school
- Review assemblies and improve the format
- Investigate ways to improve class room temperature control

- Girls Club continues to thrive. We have also improved the variety of our school uniform and staged a fashion show to launch this. Girls Club has extended its curriculum to include offsite trips.
- We amended the use of planner for the academic year 2018/19 and have kept them under review for 2019/20. We will change them to note books only with some key information pages for this September.
- This year we have tried to make assembly themes more engaging and interactive and slightly shorter. We have ensured all assemblies use a stage so that everyone can see. Year 11 pupils have an assembly on Mondays and do not attend singing practice.
- We have purchased high quality fans for use in relevant classrooms during the summer weather and fitted individual radiators with temperature controls. We are trialling tinted windows in some classrooms for this summer.

As a result of the feedback from the survey for this year we have identified the following actions:

- To ensure all parents are fully aware of all homework opportunities (including SAM Learning) that the school provides
- To review Parents Evenings and consider how to make timings of meetings even more accessible
- To ensure toilets are clean and locks are working
- To ensure school lunch is enjoyed by as many pupils as possible
- To acquire our school therapy dog
