## **New Covid Guidance**

As you are aware the guidance regarding Covid changed on 16<sup>th</sup> August 2021.

The important changes are:

From 16th August you will NOT be required to self-isolate if you live in the same household as someone with Covid-19 if any of the following apply:-

- You are fully vaccinated
- You are below the age of 18 years and 6 months
- You have taken part in or are currently part of an approved Covid 19 vaccine trial
- You are not able to get vaccinated for medical reasons

As a school we are working very hard to ensure our community remains as safe as possible. I am therefore urging parents and carers to be both cautious and vigilant. Pupils in years 7 and above have Lateral Flow Home Testing Kits which we encourage you to use weekly.

I realise the message can be quite confusing about when you should send your child to school or keep them at home. I am attaching a guide to this letter which I hope will be helpful to you and bring some clarity. If you are in any doubt, please do not hesitate to call the school office.
