Dear Parents/Carers

I am writing to provide you with some important dates for this Term in the lead up to our Annual Christmas Fair on Wednesday 4th December 5.00 till 7.00pm. This year the profits from the Fair will be going towards our fund raising project to build a much needed Drama/Therapy Room.

Bower Pots

We run a competition for pupils in the lead up to the Christmas Fair. Children are encouraged to take home a clear plastic cup with a lid and then to fill the cups with themed items such as sweets, dog biscuits, sewing items (i.e. buttons) and toiletries and to decorate the cup with a Christmas theme. The cups will be distributed on Friday 8th November and need to be returned to school no later than Monday 2nd December when the competition for the best 'Bower Pot' for each Key Stage will be judged. The pots will then be sold at our Christmas Fair.

Children in Need

Friday 15th November will be a non-school uniform day and we ask that children bring in a £1 donation which will go to Children in Need.

Treats for Trainers

On Friday 22nd November pupils are permitted to wear their choice of trainers to school with their school uniform in exchange for bringing in items of chocolate/confectionary which will be used in the Christmas Fair on a Tombola Stall.

Bottle Day

Friday 29th November is again non-school uniform day and children should bring in a bottle for donation to the bottle stall at the Christmas Fair. Bottles can include shampoo, bubble bath, ketchup or soft drinks. All alcoholic drinks are gratefully received but please inform transport escort/driver if a child has alcohol to donate and this should be brought to school reception on arrival.
