## Year 9 – Music – Home Learning 11

Last week you learned how to play 'He's a Pirate' the theme tune from 'Pirates of the Caribbean'.

### Task

Today you are going to be adding an accompaniment to the melody.

The accompaniment is the part that goes alongside the melody. It is highlighted in red on the sheet music below.

Tips:

- Only play the accompaniment which is highlighted in red
- All notes are the same length
