LO: Learning how to write lyrics

- Follow steps to write your own lyrics for a melody.

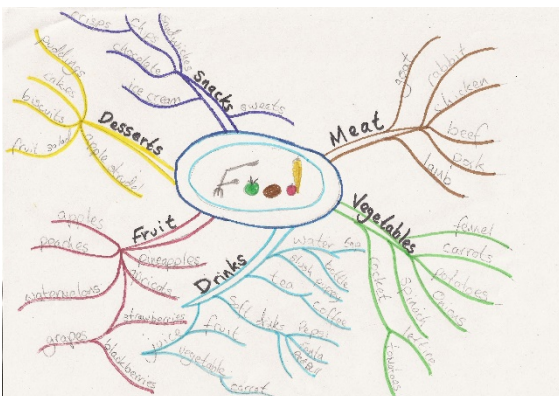
2. Listen to the examples of lyrics.

Choose a subject and a mind map either using a pen and paper or on the computer. Write down words, memories or images related to that subject. Then try to create rhyming lines from the words on your mind map.
