This week you are introducing yourselves to a new topic, **Theme and Variations**.

The **theme** in this video is 'Happy Birthday' and the performer then uses Dynamics, Pitch, Tonality and Harmony (among other things) to make her own **variations** on the theme.

2) You are going to use the online music maker from last week to make your own variations of a famous theme.

The theme is: **Ode to Joy** by **Ludwig Van Beethoven**

It's a very famous piece of classical music and this section is possibly the most recognisable.

Creating a Variation:

Here are some examples of how you could create a variation.

- Change the instrument
- Add a rhythm or beat underneath
- Change some of the notes to give it a different mood (make sure it still sounds similar to the theme)
- Change the accompaniment
- Double each note
- Play the melody backwards
