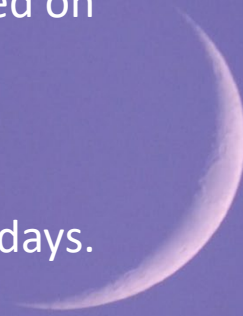
1. How long does Ramadan last for?

Ramadan begins the morning after people see the crescent moon. It can last for 29 or 30 days. This is about one month.
