If you have access to the internet

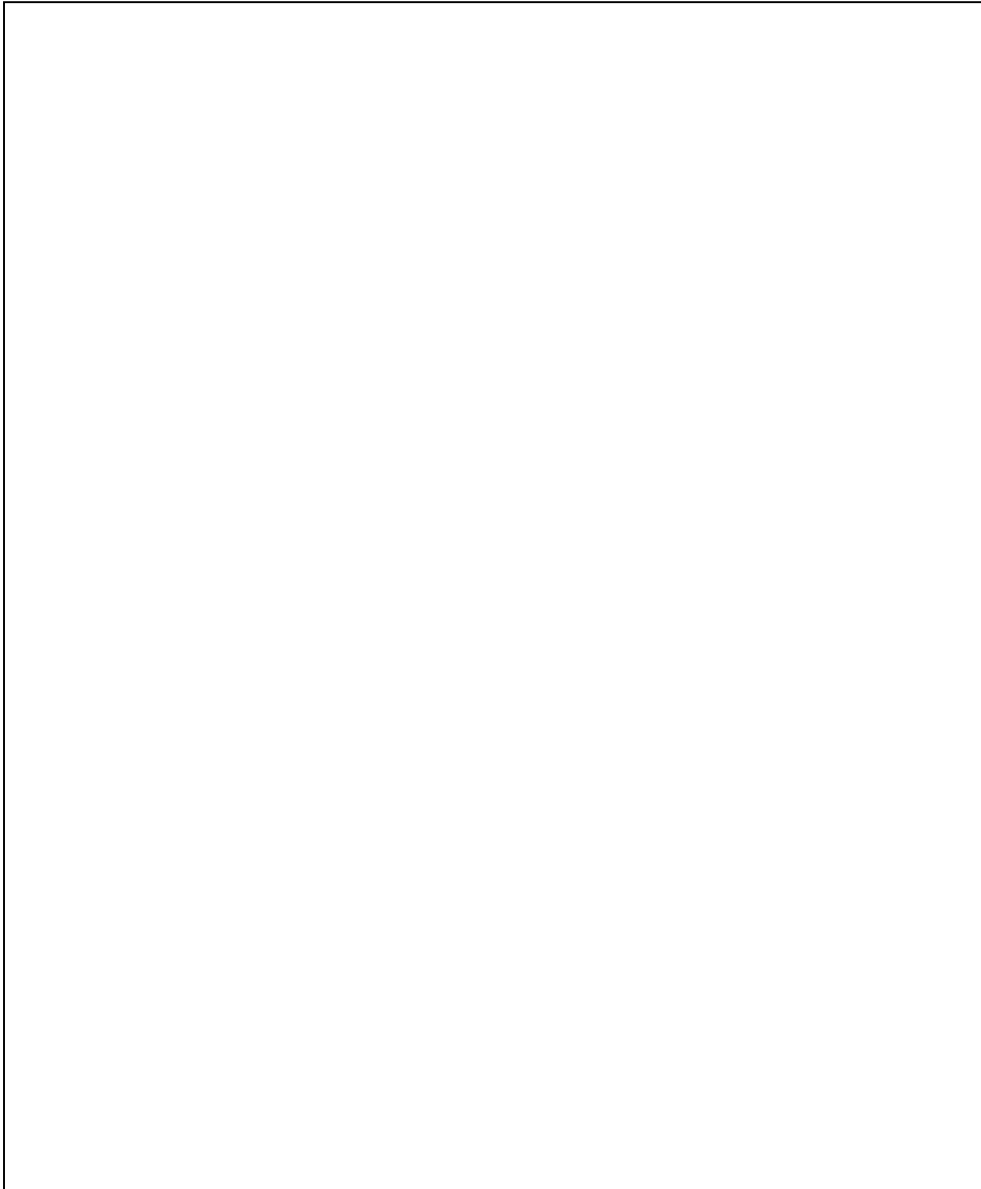
- 1) Using suitable websites find an outfit and shoes appropriate to wear for the interview
