## **PUPILS - I WILL:**

- Attend school regularly, be on time and follow staff instructions
- Work hard and try my best to complete all tasks required of me, in and out of the classroom
- Follow the school rules, behave responsibly and be polite without swearing or using words that upset people both in school and the wider community
- Accept any sanctions that may be given as a result of breaking the school rules (Behaviour Guidelines Booklet)
- Remember, when in school uniform that I am representing the school and understand that any poor behaviour will be dealt with as if the incident had occurred at school
- Treat others as I would wish to be treated and talk to a member of staff if I have a problem
- Respect all school property and take care of the environment
- Hand in my mobile phone and any other electronic equipment at the start of the day
- Not bring drinks, including fizzy drinks, into school unless a special arrangement has been agreed with my parent/carer
- Not wear make-up, nail varnish or false nails unless it is a non uniform day
- Not wear jewellery, facial or body piercings other than one stud in each ear
- Not bring any type of chewing gum

## **PARENTS/ CARERS - I/WE WILL:**

- Ensure my child attends school regularly, is on time, ensure my child is appropriately dressed in school uniform and is properly equipped i.e. PE kit
- Fully support all school policies and guidelines for discipline, behaviour and healthy life-style choices
- Ensure my child shows respect for school property and in the case of deliberate damage, agree to contribute towards the cost of any repairs
- Work in partnership with the school to support any individual programmes
- Help my child understand that everyone is of equal importance, encouraging them to appreciate and respect the views and religions of others
- Support my child's learning by attending Annual Review Meetings, multi-agency meetings and any other meetings which involve my child
- · Ensure that my child is not taken out of school without good reason during term time to enable continuity of learning
- Support my child's learning opportunities at home, including homework and reading
- Contact the school if my child is to be absent and be available, or advise the school of a named adult should the need arise for my child to leave school early
- Ensure that the school always has up to date emergency contact numbers and is made aware of any factors that may affect or impact upon my child's behaviour i.e. forgetting to give my child their medication
- Ensure that my child has taken any necessary medication before school and that if medication is needed during the school day that the school always has a sufficient supply of the medication

- Ensure that any form of bullying and racist, sexist and other discriminating behaviour, including swearing with the intention to offend is not tolerated
- Offer extra-curricular activities that will develop broader skills to prepare your child for life and the world of work
- Promote healthy life-style choices
