and toffee apples to apple juice and cider! Pupils voted and the most popular product was Apple Crumble with the Bower Grove nickname of “Apple Goodies”

With spoil issues and storage a problem they decided to peel, cut and freeze the apples as quickly as possible.

Consultation and support from the Food Technology department enabled a simple but tasty recipe to be formed.

Pupils worked together to produce the first batch of Apple Goodies which were sold to staff receiving very positive feedback and further orders being requested.

Pupils then worked incredibly hard to use up all the apples, price and label the product in time for the Christmas Fair where they sold out in the first 2 hours!

Pupils learnt valuable skills throughout the process taking ownership of the task from the very beginning.
